Wagga & District Scale Model Club Show & Exhibition Rules

1. Upon payment of entry, the entrant agrees to abide by the following rules.
2. Judges decisions are final.
3. If any person is found to have entered a model for competition that he or she has not built, then that person will be disqualified and any trophies and or ribbons, or prizes that have been awarded will be forfeited (unless the model has been completely stripped down and completely rebuilt)
4. Where there are not enough entries in any section, then the club reserve the right to combine or cancel categories & classes on the day at the clubs & judge's discretion.
5. Age groups for juniors, intermediates, and seniors are as follows:-Juniors are under 12 years. Intermediate 12 years and under 17 years. Seniors 17 years and over.
6. Any person in juniors who is found to be over the above age for the section will disqualified and prizes and trophies forfeited.
7. Where there is any ladies sections the lady owner of the model or models they can choose the have these models entered and judged with the men's classes (there is no prejudice)
8. If any disputes of any kind arise that cannot be resolved by the judges or by a member from three (3) clubs, then the judging committee of the W&DSMC must preside and their decision will be final.
9. All disputes must be presented to the judges prior to the closing of doors for public viewing on the Saturday of the show to enable time for a fair decision to be reached. All parties involved in the dispute will then be told the outcome of their dispute on the Sunday morning of the show.
10. **A standard model** is a model that has been built from only one kit and has not had any other part or parts from another kit or things such as plastruct, evergreen, wood, fibreglass, etc, added or modified.
 - a. Standard models must be built as per kit instructions only using those parts included in that kit including the supplied decals, painting is a free option. Missing forbidden decals (Tobacco, alcohol, etc) and chrome foil may be added to a standard model.
11. **An enhanced model** is a model that still retains the original kits parts, with additions such as mudflaps, aerals, decals, engine wiring, etc – **up to 3 items added/changed** - A list of changes must be provided to support entry to this category.
12. **A modified model** are kits which have had any part or parts from another kit or kits added, or where any other material (**up to 6 items added/changed**) such as plastruct, evergreen, wood, fibreglass, etc, added to alter the model from standard – A list of changes must be provided to support entry to this category.
 - a. A model which has had the doors cut from the body and made to open and close, or where a bulbar has been made from the above mentioned materials or parts added to an existing rolling chassis, or body can be bought from various suppliers, then the model will be determined as modified.
 - b. Where the above-mentioned materials have been used in the kit that is **greater than 6 items added/changed**, the model the model will be deemed as **advanced modified** - – A list of changes must be provided to support entry to this category.
13. Models entered into scratch built section must be 80% scratch built.
14. **Model of Show**, previous model of show winner are not eligible to be judged fir this major show award.
15. If there is any dispute to the classification of a model, then a decision of the judges must be sought and this decision will be final. Alternatively, if judges are not available, a group of three (3) members from different clubs can make a decision and this will be final.
16. All care and security will be taken by the W&DSMC, but no responsibility for models that are left for display or judging that may be damaged or lost. Models will only to be handled by judges, W&DSMC executive committee, or by the owner of the model.
17. Presentation of trophies will take place on Sunday approximately. 3pm.
18. All models to be left on display presentation on the Sunday, unless prior arrangements have been made with the executive of the W&DSMC.
